- b. Conformity of goods to documents concerning their customs value, kinds, models, types, quantities.
- c. Authenticity and validity of documents provided for an import entry.
- c. Authenticity and validity of Company documents provided for the authorization granted to the Customs Clearance Agency.

Please enclose copies of your valid (not older than 3 months) Company documents certified by a Notary Public/Customs Authority/issuing authority (The National Court Register, NIP). The stamp duty fee amounting to PLN 17.00 for the issue of the present authorization will be added to a fee due for the first customs clearance. The Present authorization may be signed by a person/persons authorized to represent the Company and specified in the extract from the Register of Entrepreneurs or in the Certificate from the Business Activity Register.
